Classroom teachers participate in professional development including LETRS training for the 2023-2024 school year. This training will allow teachers to implement instructional strategies in a unified manner across the grade span to strengthen the academic program. Incoming teachers will also be trained in Volume 1 before the start of the school year so they are up to date with implementation methods. All teachers in the elementary will be trained in Volumes 1-2 by December 2023.
